Princeville School District is dedicated to strategic planning to facilitate meaningful, continual improvement in all aspects of the educational system. Through a collaborative process, the Princeville School District Board of Education and school community identify an on-going strategic plan based on long-range goals and objectives for the Princeville Schools. Participation is encouraged from all aspects of the School District community—District staff, parents, students, and community members. Under the leadership of a representative Educational Strategies Team, an annual strategic action plan is developed to address the goals and objectives. This action plan provides activities and suggested strategies to accomplish each objective. The action plan includes persons responsible and timelines for each activity. The Princeville School District Strategic Plan is a living, ever-changing document that is periodically reviewed, evaluated, and reported to the public. Complete copies of the Princeville School District Strategic Plan are available in the District Office upon request.

The Princeville School District Strategic Plan is based on these components:

- **District Goal Statements** are those overarching statements that are of a long-range aim or purpose. District Goal Statements are not generally limited to a time period or stated in strict measurable terms. They are the foundation of the strategic plan and school program.
- **Objectives** are those areas of emphasis found under each district goal statement that provide focus on what is to be addressed in meeting the goal. This focus is evaluated periodically and may be sustained for an extended period of time.
- **Activities** are the foundation of the annual strategic plan and action plan. They are measurable and observable results or ends. Activities are judged to be realistic and attainable by a specific future point in time through the successful implementation of a planned course of action. Activities are more short term and are annually accomplished, reviewed, revised, and additional activities identified.

Emphasize quality professional development for all staff members. 5. Identify and implement technology program improvements to increase the integration of technology into curriculum and instruction.

Explore resource sharing with the community and other school districts.
